#### FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

The fourth Sunday in Lent is known by a variety of names. Laetare Sunday (literally Rejoice Sunday) comes from the idea that we start to lift our eyes towards the joy that is to come. It is the mid-point of Lent, and traditionally the fast is temporarily relaxed, so is also known as Refreshment Sunday. In English tradition it is Mothering Sunday - the Sunday that those in domestic service were allowed home to worship with their own families in their 'mother' churches. In all these cases, this Sunday becomes a little celebration in anticipation of Easter.

Lent is not simply a time of denial. We do not practise the empty ritual of a season of discipline simply for the sake of it. Rather, we engage in a time of preparation.

Today we remind ourselves for what it is we are preparing, just before we descend into the depths of despair, walking alongside Jesus as in the coming weeks we engage with his trial and death. Today we lift our eyes towards the joy of Easter, reminding ourselves of the salvation that is coming, that we might more fully engage with Passiontide.

And do engage. There's so much going on in the parish in terms of our Lent study group, stations of the cross, and variety of services - do come to as much as you can, in order that on Easter Day you might rejoice all the more! You'll find at the back of the order of service, and circulated separately, a flyer with all our Holy Week and Easter services. I would encourage you all to endeavour to come on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Day (particularly the 5am service will be a magical celebration!) so as to get the full experience of our walk alongside Jesus from death into newness of life.
