

FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

The prophet Isaiah exclaims, "all we, like sheep, have gone astray!" and some of my favourite family holidays growing up were spent in the countryside surrounded by the gentle "baa-ing" of sheep – seeing them being herded in, corralled by dogs and quad bikes and generally prevented from going astray! This is a troublesome metaphor indeed, unless we are to see ourselves as being without choice, without identity, being helplessly herded towards heaven or hell.

Fortunately, there is another model of shepherdry. Jesus describes himself as shepherd and gatekeepers - 'the good shepherd', quite unlike the hired hands or stranger who scatter at the first sign of trouble, who do not know and love the sheep individually - Jesus knows his own and his own know him, just as he has that relationship with the Father. So intimate is the Good Shepherd's relationship with us sheep, that it is on a level with his relationship with the Father.

That is good news indeed. We are not just a face in the crowd to Jesus, but, though we are called to be one flock, we are still each individually known by the shepherd. And loved - to the point where the shepherd lays down his life for the flock. We tell Adelaide this as she is baptised, and are grateful for the reminder to us all.

Today we give thanks for Christ, the Good Shepherd, and we pray that we might all be one flock, with one shepherd - the Risen Lord Jesus.
