



FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

I don't know about you, but last Sunday afternoon, on arriving home from what was, it's fair to say, a busy week in the life of our parish I was heard to exclaim "it is finished!"

You might recognise these words as those of our Lord as he gave up his spirit on Good Friday. They are certainly not meant for utterance on Easter Day! Partly because of course, Easter is far from the end - rather it is only the beginning of our new relationship with God in Jesus Christ, our risen Lord.

As the season of Easter progresses (50 days, in case you were wondering... until Pentecost!) we work through various 'resurrection appearances'.

These appearances are not veiled mystical experiences for the disciples - but rather they are substantial, real experiences of Jesus, their friend, their teacher, and as Thomas eventually comes to proclaim, their God.

Jesus rising on Easter day isn't the end. It's only the beginning - the beginning of our relationship with the risen Lord in the flesh. In the flesh of the bread and wine that we share daily, and in the flesh of all whom we encounter, in whom Jesus makes himself known to us. It is far from finished!
